Giulio (Valerio Mastandrea) is 40 years old and leads an apparently quiet life.

A rented house, a permanent job, a car he is paying up, a rebellious but likeable daughter and a sweet dreamer of a son, a wife (Barbora Bobulova) whom he loves and betrays. Giulio is caught out and abandoned and all of a sudden his fairy tale collapses.

But what happens to a present-day couple who “dare” to separate?

BALANCING ACT follows a series of events, some tragic, some ironic, taking us by the hand into the world of a man who suddenly discovers how ephemeral is the border between wellbeing and poverty.

Ivano De Matteo, Roman, in his 40s, began his artistic career in 1990, graduating from the "Il Mulino by Fiora" theatre laboratory directed by Perla Peragallo. Actor, director and documentary-maker in a constant search for a personal language, he moves between theatre, cinema and television. He founded *Il Cantiere* Company in 1993 with Valentina Ferlan (author and scriptwriter). In 2005 he founded the small production company UTOPIA FILM.

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RODEO DRIVE was set up in 1991 by Marco Poccioni and Marco Valsania.

Marco Poccioni

Born in Rome on 2/11/1960. He graduated in law from the "La Sapienza" University, Rome, in 1984. He began working at Medusa Distribution, the company of his father, Franco, and Felice Colaiacomo, dealing with the production, marketing and distribution of a number of films produced by Medusa up to 1988, the year when the company was sold.

In 1991 with Marco Valsania he set up Rodeo Drive with which he began his personal journey in Italian independent cinema which would lead him to produce a significant number of films, with some of Italy's most important directors.

Marco Valsania

Born in Roma on 23/1/57. He began working in 1978 at ECI (Esercizi Cinematografici Italiani) dealing with programming in the cinemas run by the company throughout Italy.

In 1980 he bought the Embassy and Eden cinemas in Rome and became a partner with Pietro Garinei in running the Teatro Sistina.

He produced Francesco Nuti's first two films "Madonna che silenzio c'è stasera" and "Io Chiara e lo Scuro" and in 1991 with Marco Poccioni he set up Rodeo Drive with which he began his personal journey in Italian independent cinema which would lead him to produce a significant number of films, with some of Italy's most important directors.
